What is Prayer Ministry?

God has given us access to his power for healing and life through prayer. Prayer ministry uses the discernment of the Holy Spirit to help people experience healing and freedom in Jesus' name.

Why is Prayer Ministry Important?

Human beings are created in God's image, complex and wonderful – designed to know joy, peace, purpose and freedom. Jesus promised us: *"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."* (John 10:10). However the reality is we live in a broken world where hurt happens robbing us of the joy, peace, purpose and freedom God intends for us.
