What is 'The Work Party'?

'The Work Party' is a practical ministry of property maintenance and improvement, for both MountyChurch and the local community. It is a vehicle for enjoying fellowship within the church, as well as extending the love of Christ within the local community by serving their practical needs with works of love.

'The Work Party' provides minor handyman work to buildings and area beautification, in a voluntary capacity for individuals and community groups who do not have the resources required for the work.

'The Work Party' allows men and women associated with MountyChurch the opportunity to contribute their skills toward practical projects which serve our church and community of Mt Hawthorn and surrounds.

'The Work Party' invites participation of friends, families, and neighbours, offering a practical place for evangelism on a personal and community level. It is an opportunity for those on the team to meet practical needs and reach out with serving and practical love.

The purpose of this ministry is to bring honour to God's name within the environs of the Mt Hawthorn community by serving people with care and love. 'The Work Party' offers opportunity to worship God through practical service.

How Does It Operate?

'The Work Party' initially aims to work on 9 projects per year, with 3 around the church building and grounds, 3 for needs within the MountyChurch congregation (eg. seniors, single mums, etc), and 3 for needs within the wider Mt Hawthorn community (eg. schools, community centres, etc). We invite submissions for assistance from anyone with a suggestion. The ministry team will assess the need, scope the project and decide whether 'The Work Party' can provide the necessary assistance within the Service and Safety Guidelines.
